YOUR MOVING CHECKLIST

Use our checklist to minimize stress and simplify the packing and moving process so you can focus on the good stuff: settling into your new Florida home.

YOUR MOVING CHECKLIST

One Month Before the Big Move:	One Week Before the Move:
Research moving companies, make contact and secure written estimates. Research each company's insurer as well as how claims are made if the property is damaged.	Confirm your moving reservations (moving company or truck rental).
After making comparisons, it's time to chose your moving company, make your reservation and confirm, dates, times, and costs.	Secure your important documents and carry them with you. They shouldn't be packed with your other belongings.
Update your address with the USPS (United States Postal Service) – it can be completed easily online with no trip to the Post Office needed. You'll also need to notify the IRS (Internal Revenue Service) of your new address.	Have any prescriptions transferred to your new pharmacy, or if mail-order, make sure to update your new address.
If needed, transfer school records for your children.	Notify the bank of your move or transfer your accounts as needed.
Ask your family's physicians for referrals if needed and inquire about the process of transferring medical records to your new doctors.	Clean as you pack, making sure to empty cabinets, closets, and appliances.
Notify and update insurance information – home, auto, health, etc. Ask if your personal property is covered during the transition to your new home in Florida.	Notify your friends and family of your new address. The Day Before the Move:
Schedule cancellation of utilities, cable, internet, lawn care, pool care, etc. at your old home, as well as installation and start-up of these services at your new home.	Make sure you have cash on hand for unexpected expenses.
Notify your creditors of your new address.	Have water and snacks for moving day and your travel days.
Declutter your home as you prepare your items for packing. Now is the time to make donations (taxdeductible), have a yard sale, and get rid of items you no	Pack your final boxes, with the exception of traveling clothes and toiletries needed.

Once the decluttering is complete, start prepping to pack your items.	Note any meter readings in case of discrepancy with your final utility bills.
Two Weeks Before the Move:	Supervise your movers and verify details regarding your new address as well as the time to expect delivery.
Verify utility and home services cancellation dates.	
If you are packing, gather the needed packing supplies – boxes, tape, packing material, etc.	Make plans to arrive at your destination before the movers.
